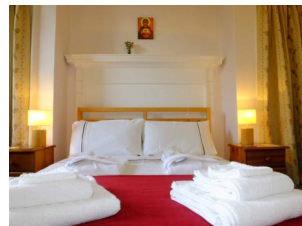
## Retreat leaders
